cause

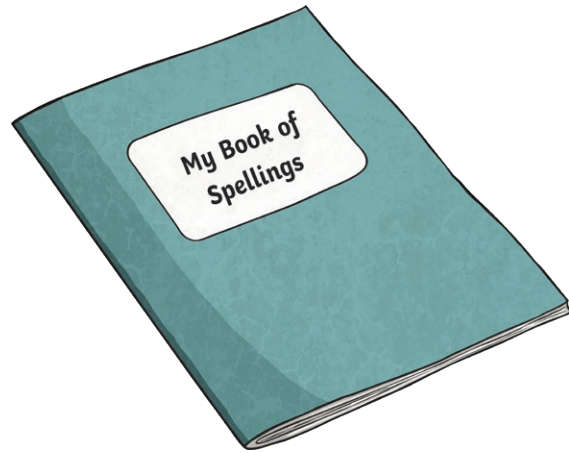
