## **EYFS** news

In reception class, the children have been learning more about VE day. They have made medals, flags, bunting, mixed paint colours using red, white and blue and been preparing to perform their song in the assembly on Thursday afternoon. I am sure you will have heard them singing it at home. Maths work has focused on making shapes fit and rotating shapes. The children really enjoyed the game we played using the numicon, trying to find ways to fill a square with numicon of different numbers. Quite a challenge for us all! The forest school session this week was chance for the children to choose a plot, dig a hole and plant some wild flower seeds. We will see what grows!

Pre -School children have been learning more about transport and trains. They have been enjoying the story 'The Runaway Train' and also singing the nursery rhyme 'A Sailor Went to Sea, Sea, Sea'. Thursday was VE day themed - red, white and blue playdough, a tea party, bunting and music. Maths this week has been focused on shape- making shapes fit in spaces (completing puzzles) and matching shapes to find one the same

In the nursery, the theme is transport again but going on a bus. The children have been singing 'The Wheels on the Bus' and enjoyed learning about the celebrations on VE Day. They decorated bunting and played with lots of red, white and blue resources such as cloud dough and drawing materials. They talked about the union flag and really enjoyed showing their costumes to everyone as they arrived in school.
