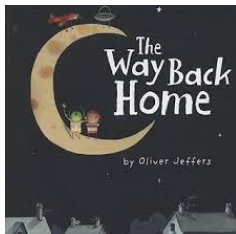
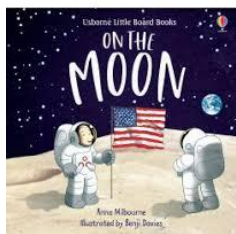




Key Knowledge and Skills
