# **EYFS** news

The reception children have continued on the animal topic this week reading 'Rumble in the Jungle.' They have written about the animals from the story. We have worked hard on accuracy and handwriting presentation and will continue to work on this next week. Maths work has focused on mapping skills and following directions and instructions to place an object or build models. They have enjoyed sharing the classroom with the pre- school class and showing them around the room and modelling how we play. During forest school, the children read 'Walking Through the Jungle' and had to move in different ways as they searched for the animals from the book.

Pre school children have been listening to a lovely story this week called 'Mama's sleeping scarf', singing rhymes which count forwards and back from 5 and counting forwards and back from 5 to introduce the concept of subtraction.

Nursery children have been learning more about pets. The focus is dogs this week. They have been singing 'How Much is that Doggy?', reading 'Dear Zoo' and have loved moving in different ways like animals in games like 'Simon says'. Forest school was all about collecting natural 'treasures' and pressing them into clay. The forest is in full bloom right now so there were plenty of things to choose from!
