## BEHAVIOUR CATEGORY 1

## BEHAVIOUR CATEGORY 2

- Not following direct adult instructions
- Not being respectful towards adults or other children
- Shouting or calling out resulting in a distraction to others
- Running around school rather than walking
- Not being on task
- Not being honest
- Play fighting
- Littering
- Leaving the classroom without permission

- Repeated category 1 behaviour
- Persistent disruptive behaviour
- Repeated refusal/defiance
- Deliberate damage to property
- Throwing objects in the classroom
- Verbal aggression towards others
- Threatening or intimidating behaviour
- Deliberately hurting another person
- Bullying behaviour
- Peer-on-peer abuse
- Not being safe online
- Use of inappropriate language
- Any form of discrimination, including racist or homophobic language
- Spitting at another person
- Theft
- Leaving the school grounds without permission

## ACTIONS AND CONSEQUENCES

- Quiet warning
- Second warning and time out
- Restorative conversation

If I do not change my behaviour, following the above actions, I will miss my playtime for 2 days

- Catch up on any missed work
- Parents/carers informed
- Category 1 behaviour logged

- Time out in a separate area
- Restorative conversation
- Miss playtime for 5 days
- Catch up on any missed work
- Parents/carers informed
- Category 2 behaviour logged
- Formal behaviour meeting held with parent/carer, class teacher and a Senior Teacher

If required I will be placed on a behaviour report card where my behaviour will be closely monitored

If I do not change my behaviour, following the above actions, further consequences will be considered including an internal or external exclusion
