Year 3 Swimming

The year 3 weekly swimming will be on Wednesday 7th January. Children will require a suitable swimming costume for their lessons. The girls should wear a one-piece bathing suit, not a bikini, and the boys wear fitted swim trunks. All children need to bring a towel.

Earrings are not permitted during swimming lessons; if your child has recently had their ears pierced and they cannot take them out, please provide your child with a swimming cap that will cover the earrings. Children will not be able to wear goggles during their swimming lessons.

Middlewich has 3 canals and 3 rivers in the town therefore water safety is of paramount importance and the children need to be able to swim safely without goggles.
